

Scholarship schemes

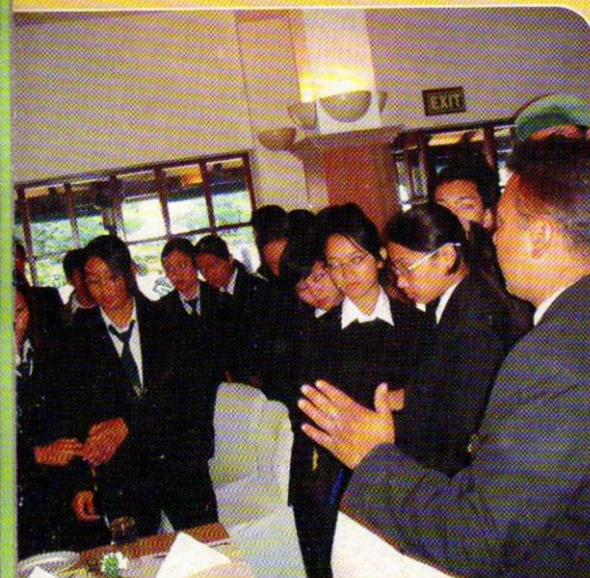
To encourage deserving, meritorious, economically backward and under privileged students, NSS offers a wide range of scholarship programmes as follows:

Science Stream

1. Five students enrolled in NSS securing higher score in SLC (preferably Top Ten) will get full scholarship i.e. 12 months tuition fee off for grade XI.
2. NSS Entrance Exam toppers (2 boys and 2 girls) will get full scholarship in grade XI. However, If they are unable to secure distinction marks in terminal examinations, they will be disqualified for full scholarship.
3. NSS Entrance Exam Toppers (40 students) will get partial Scholarship on the basis of entrance examination score.
4. District toppers, If have a good score in NSS entrance exam, will get 20% off in total tuition fee.
5. Students securing 85% or above in the SLC and good score in NSS entrance exam will get 100% deduction in Admission fee.
6. Deserving & Economically deprived/under privileged/marginalized students will get full or partial scholarship on the basis of the recommendation of HSEB.
7. Top Ten position holders in NSS Term/Test Examination will get full or partial scholarship for the following three months.
8. Free Tuition fee will be provided in Grade XII for top students securing 85% or above in the Higher Secondary Board Examination of grade XI.

Management Stream

1. 100% waiver in monthly fee for a student securing highest marks in NSS Entrance Test.
2. 100% deduction in monthly fee (Twelve months) for those securing 80% marks or above in SLC aggregate provided that they score at least 65% in entrance test.
3. 100% deduction in Admission fee for students securing 70% marks or above in SLC aggregate.
4. 50% deduction in Admission fee for students securing 65% marks or above in SLC aggregate.
5. Free tuition fee will be provided in class XII for the students who secure highest marks among NSS students in HSEB Examination of Class XI.
6. Deserving & Economically deprived /Under Privileged/ marginalized students will get full or partial scholarship on the basis of the recommendation of HSEB.
7. Free Tuition fee will be provided in Grade XII for top students securing 80% or above in the Higher Secondary Board Examination of grade XI.

The college duly affiliated to Tribhuvan University has launched 4-year's accademic programme in food technology with an aim to produce experts and efficient manpower in the related field.

Admission Procedure

Minimum requirement to apply for admission in Faculty of Science is the First Division with optional Maths in S.L.C. or equivalent.

Minimum requirement to apply for admission in Faculty of Management is 50% in S.L.C. Separate Entrance Test is held for FOS and FOM as follows:

Science Stream			
1.	English	25 Marks	Time: 2 hrs
2.	Science	35 Marks	
3.	Mathematics	40 Marks	
All questions are objective except 5 marks essay in English			

Management Stream			
1.	English	40 Marks	Time: 1½ hrs
2.	Mathematics	60 Marks	
All objective Questions except 10 marks essay in English			

Students getting through written examination will be scrutinized through Interview. Successful Students in written Test and cleared through Interview will be eligible to take the admission in a given time frame.

Evaluation System

One unit test and two terminal examinations are conducted prior to the pre-board exam. Re-tests and Internal Practical exams are also held. All tests are compulsory. The students must pass the pre-board exam to appear in HSEB final exam.
